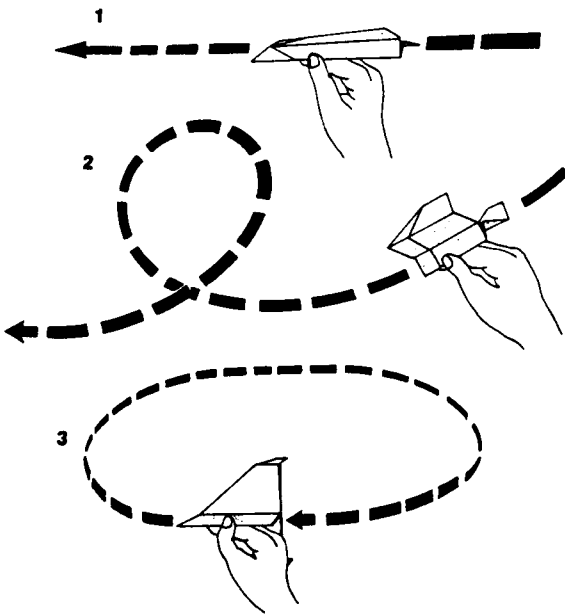


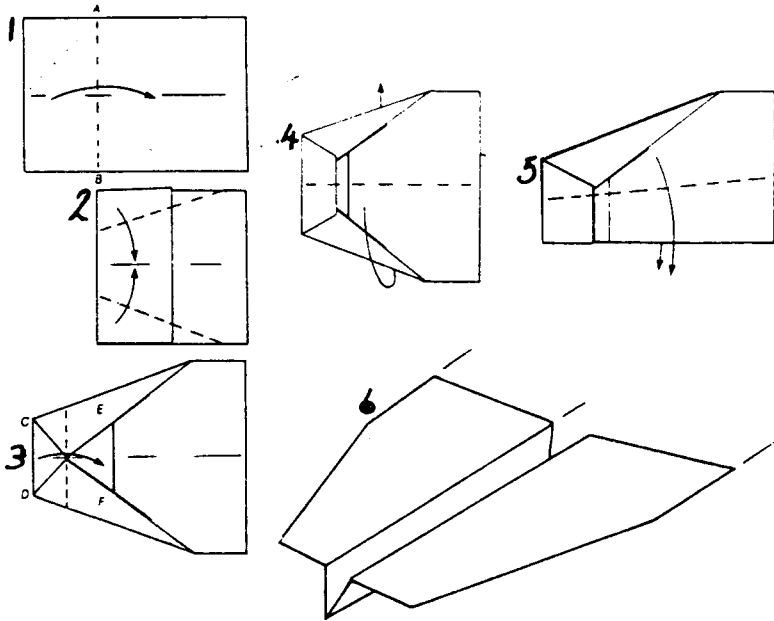
# Paper Planes
